Committee, regarding "Videos for Young People", would like to express their gratitude for the support and cooperation received from general service area delegates on the gathering of sharing from young people.

CORRECTIONS: G.S.O. Staff have responded to an average of 654 inmate letters monthly over the last three months. This assignment linked 512 inmates, inside A.A. inmates to outside A.A. members, through corrections correspondences service during this period.

A.A.WS. WEB SITE: The launch of G.S.O.'s re-designed A.A. Web Site, www.aa.org has expanded access to historical and current information on Alcoholics Anonymous. In 2005, the web site had over 3,000,000 visits. 27% over 2004. G.S.O. anticipates the number of visits will continue to increase.

PUBLICIATIONS: Total distribution of all books in 2005 was 2,104,525, down 5% from 2004's total of 2,219,591 units.

Next month CMIA will be in Pinckney, District 8, on April 2, 2006.

In closing I would like to give District 10 a special thanks for holding Intra-Area twice in just three months. A Great commitment to service work.
